When to use Compass+

There are many sections of Compass+, each designed to support the Careers Leader to: assess your careers provision against the Gatsby Benchmarks; plan and track activities for individual learners; track individual learners' careers interests and intended destinations as well as actual destinations; input and store details of third-party organisations and contacts that can support your careers provision; gather learner perceptions around careers provision; download key information into reports.

The key features are:

- **1.** <u>Compass evaluation</u>: Quickly and easily evaluate your careers activities against the eight Gatsby Benchmarks.
- 2. <u>Activities</u>: Enter BM1 activity to ensure you are developing a stable careers programme and evidencing statutory compliance. Enter BM2-8 activities to record and map-out all planned careers activities.
- **3.** Learner data: view current learners and those who have left; view by form group, gender, characteristics (FSM, PP, SEN, EAL.) Record personal guidance interviews, consent for tracking interests, intended and actual destinations.
- **4.** <u>Future Skills Questionnaire</u>: measure the career readiness of your learners and gather learner voice
- **5.** <u>Apprenticeships</u>: to increase awareness of, and interest in apprenticeships, see the feed of all current apprenticeship vacancies then filter by distance, level, sector.
- **6.** <u>Careers Partners</u>: safely and easily store information about employers and organisations who can help to deliver careers activities. Access when creating activities to assign contacts to the activity. Use the Provider Directory to find/contact delivery partners.
- **7.** <u>Help Centre</u>: view articles, sign up for webinars, access training opportunities and resources, keep up-to-date with the latest Compass+ news.

ENTERPRISE C⊕MPASS +

Compass+ is a free digital tool which enables you to benchmark, track and report on your careers provision at individual learner level.

Using Compass+ is recommended as good practice by the Department For Education.

Complete a Compass evaluation if you haven't done one this term. Compare your results with National/Regional statistics and screenshot ready to discuss with your Line Manager.

Enter key Benchmark 1 activities to check your statutory compliance. Make sure you have a <u>progressive careers programme</u>. Enter your big-ticket <u>BM2-8 activities</u>. If you use a <u>Partner Platform</u>, upload activities from the Partner Platform into Compass+.

Thinking Ahead: Plan when to deliver the Future Skills Questionnaire. Start with Y7 or Y12 to use as a baseline. Use the outcomes to identify strengths, trends and patterns, check negative responses (potential NEETs/signposting for pastoral support) and identify most positive responses to lead future discussions, for when Ofsted visit for example. Share findings with key stakeholders.
